

NOMINATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Please type all information on the Nomination Form or a separate sheet of paper.
- 2) Include with this nomination two (2) letters of recommendation. To avoid errors, and in the interest of uniformity, please limit letters to one typewritten page each.
- 3) Please include a limited number of newspaper clippings, magazine articles and other supportive materials that would be helpful to the Hall of Fame Screening Committee. If support material is difficult to obtain, an additional letter may be submitted to substantiate the individual's or organization's accomplishments or contributions.

If nominee is elected to the Hall of Fame, the nominator must secure a photo of the inductee to be used on the photo plaque and for marketing purposes.

All information on this form must be completed and supporting letters of recommendation received on or before July 1. The completed nomination form and support materials should be sent to:

Once the committee receives the nomination form, all actions necessary to the selection process shall remain confidential. The Rockford Area Golf Hall of Fame shall retain all information submitted. **Incomplete nomination forms will be returned, and may be resubmitted by July 1 or for the following year.**

Any organization or individual may submit a nomination form for the Rockford Area Golf Hall of Fame. It is strongly recommended that each individual or organization nominate only one new candidate per year. If an individual or organization feels the need to nominate more than one person, these individuals should be ranked.

The Rockford Area Golf Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony is held each year in conjunction with the Rockford Area Golf Hall of Fame Golf Outing. The ceremony is usually held the third week in September. Inductees will be notified in mid-August of their selection.

CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION

All candidates will be judged on their significant and/or long-term contributions to Rockford area golf. While many have served Rockford golf over a long and distinguished career, their accomplishments must have been worthy of local recognition for them to be considered. Longevity, without meaningful local impact, does not constitute appropriate credentials for Hall of Fame consideration.

Nominees must exemplify the highest standards of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and moral character. All nominees must be at least 40 years of age in order to be considered for induction.

Nominations for the Hall of Fame are reviewed for accuracy and completeness, then forwarded to the Selection Committee.
